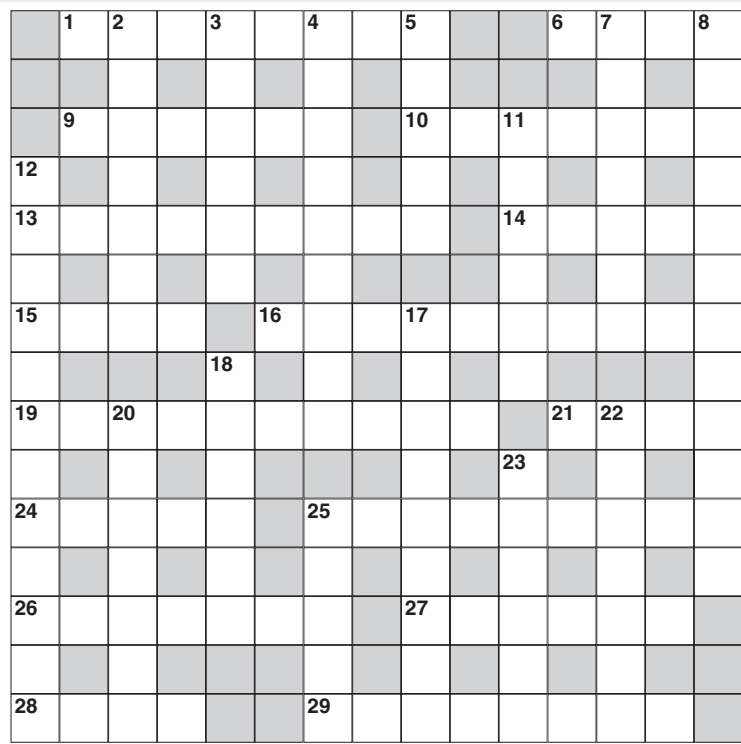


The Hindu Crossword 7921
